
We suggest a route, and most of the questions are in the route order, but the answers to Q25 and Q26 may be anywhere on the route, so keep your eyes open for them all the time.



Q26 There are a lot of names on display in the village. Where are Al, Alf, Bert, Leo, Les and Sid?




